Dear Church Family,

It seems like only yesterday we were having healthy discussions at our annual church meeting and soon we will be entering the 40 day spiritual renewal time of Lent. This special season of focusing on Jesus’ suffering, death, burial and resurrection is beneficial for both the individual believer and the body of Christ here at Woodlawn Baptist Church.

We will engage in two different studies during Lent. Beginning on February 22, Ash Wednesday, we will study the personal name of God—Jehovah—which was first revealed to Moses at the burning bush. The remaining Wednesdays we will study: Jehovah-Jireh; Jehovah-Nissi; Jehovah-Shalom; Jehovah-Shammah and Jehovah-Tsidkenu.

The other study will begin on Sunday evening February 26 at 6pm and continue through the Sunday’s of Lent. This study is called “Intercessory Prayer” by Dutch Sheets which involves a video presentation which will be followed by discussion groups. This study will conclude on April 22.

The Food Closet chefs have offered to make soup to be served to the Food Closet clients and the church family. You are invited to participate by signing up to bring bread, cookies and help with the clean up. Many hands will make for a blessed time of fellowship at Bread and Broth. A basket will be available to receive a free will offering to help cover the costs that will be incurred. The church family will be served soup between 5:30-6:30 pm during Bread and Broth.

The church family voted at our annual meeting to collect and send our Lenten offering to the “House of Compassion” in Cumberland which was established to provide comfort and care for those afflicted by HIV/AIDS. The director, Colleen Scanlan has agreed to enlighten us about this

ministry during our February 19 worship service.

I challenge you to read a spiritual book along with your Bible reading and view a spiritual movie from our Woodlawn Library. I also encourage you to fast and pray during the Wednesdays of Lent and hopefully break your fast at Bread and Broth.

May each of us be renewed in our personal relationship with the Lord, be strengthened in our commitment to serve Him with gladness and be blessed of the Lord and be a blessing to our fellow man. May Jesus Christ be praised!
